

To CCDW Instructors:

First of all, we wish to thank you for bringing your CCDW students to Shooter's Supply and Range for their qualifications. Many of your students have become our customers. Again, thank you for your business.

Our founder, Homer Cole, retired July 1, 2012. Alex Logsdon, who has been with Shooter's for many years, and Jeff Blank are the new owners. We wish for continued success for you and us.

Effective **January 1, 2013**, we are implementing some changes in the use of our range by CCDW instructors. These changes should make the process easier and simpler for both Shooter's and you.

- 1 Please download a copy of the range rules and liability waiver for each student. The student should complete this form before coming to our facility.
- 2 Please contact us at (859) 356-3300 a minimum of 90 minutes before your arrival. If you get sent to voicemail, please call again until you speak with a clerk. Inform the clerk the number of students you have and your arrival time. This will ensure that your shooting lane(s) will be available at your arrival. If you do not notify us in advance, your group will be put on the waiting list in the order of your arrival. At times, this wait could be substantial. If you or your group fails to arrive at the scheduled time, range fees can be increased, at the discretion of management.
- 3 Please ask your students to park on far side of the street across from Shooter's, not in the parking lot, if possible. Do not park in the Townsley Electrical Contractors parking lot next door. Cars parked in the Townsley Electrical lot are subject to towing and storage fees, at the vehicle owner's expense.
- 4 Upon your arrival, please collect the range rules and liability waiver from each student. Inform the clerk of your arrival. The range use fee is **\$10 per student**. The instructor should pay the total fee in one bill. If you wish a receipt, please inform the clerk. The clerk will assign your lane(s). The student will not receive a range card from Shooter's, as this is the policy we use for our in-house CCDW classes. Even if the student has a range card from Shooter's, they will need to complete the range rules and liability waiver before using the range.
- 5 Please note that a maximum of 2 persons per lane are allowed on the range, including the instructor(s).
- 6 As of September 1, 2012, we no longer provide hearing and eye protection. Each student must have hearing and eye protection to enter the range. Hearing and eye protection is available for purchase. The least expensive is a set of ear plugs and safety glasses, available for \$3. Ammunition is also available for purchase.
- 7 Please remind your students that all firearms must be in a holster or case to enter the building. The students can load magazines while waiting for their turn on the range, but at no time should the firearm be out of the holster or case when not on the range. Students with revolvers should wait until on the firing lane to load. **Any person that has a firearm out of the holster or case while not on the firing lane will be asked to leave the premises, without refund of fees.**
